





Triggers of Natural Disaster


- Intense/prolonged rains, storms
- Windstorms, hail
- Temperature and humidity of air extremes
- Strong winds
- Dry spells




Types of Natural Disasters

- Landslides, mudflow and debris flows
- Floods, flashfloods, floodings
- Crop failure
- Fires
- Coastal erosion
- Acute episodes of air and water pollution
- Water supply collapse
- Epidemics
